Actions



 To strategically plan over the medium term, from current readiness status (baseline) → where to be by end of Year 4 (result areas).



To coordinate action and engage relevant stakeholders

- Readiness needs and gaps identified through strategic, mediumterm planning will ultimately form the ToRs → used either:
 - For pre-qualified DPs or
 - To inform the Direct Access Proposal
- Assistance from the Secretariat upon request.
- Countries and DAEs can also utilise the expertise and resources, such as the GCF placement experts.

STEP 3 – OPTION 1. DIRECT ACCESS



Actions for NDAs & DAEs, and GCF



- Strategic, medium-term planning
- Confirm NDA/government agency or DAE can
 - Enter into a direct grant agreement with GCF
 - Receive funds directly from GCF
- FMCA
- Direct Access Proposal Submission
- Individual grant agreement

Agencies with <u>Framework</u> Readiness and Preparatory Support Grant Agreements with the GCF Secretariat might be invited directly by countries and DAEs to submit proposals to address their ToRs. <u>GCF encourages more than one FWA holder to be invited to submit a proposal.</u>

Current holders UNDP, UNEP/UNEP-CTCN, GIZ, FAO, GGGI, CCCCC, CAF, UNIDO, IDB, SPC, SPREP.

STEP 3 - OPTION 2. PRE-QUALIFIED DPs



Actions for NDAs and DAEs, and GCF



- Strategic, medium-term planning/ToR, in consultation with relevant stakeholders
- Mini tender for best proposal from prequalified DPs*
- Work Orders based on the winning proposal (no need for individual grant agreements)



- A standardised mini-tender template for DPs
- A work order for DPs*

- * GCF pre-qualifies DPs. Selection criteria, requirements, and areas of expertise will be published widely, including on local/NDA platforms. Pre-qualified DPs will be grouped per area of expertise:
 - Lot 1: Policy and Regulation lot, incl. Vulnerability and Resilience (V&R) sub-lot, Private Sector (PS) Engagement sub-lot, and Knowledge Management and Learning (KM&L)
 - Lot 2: Climate Investment Design and Implementation, incl. V&R sub-lot, PS Engagement sub-lot, and KM&L

STEP 3 – OPTION 3. HYBRID APPROACH



Actions




- Project planning and coordination with relevant stakeholders
- Readiness Access
 - For projects implemented through pre-qualified DPs, the NDA develops ToRs that are addressed via minitenders.
 - For directly access, the NDA develops Direct Access Proposal.
- Readiness Delivery
 - For direct access, Direct Access Proposal + Grant Agreement
 - For pre-qualified DPs → Mini-tenders + Work Orders

Example

- Programme 1 Specialised Support →
 pre-qualified DPs → Objective 2
 - To leverage specialised external expertise
 - To benefit from streamlined contracting processes provided under LTA arrangement
- Programme 2 Direct Implementation →
 Country or DAE → Objectives 1 and 3
 - To closely manage regulatory reform processes and other activities that benefit from a more hands-on approach or
 - To benefit from local expertise and capacities.




< \$250k remaining in committed funds

Intentional about FLEXIBILITY and SPEED of ACCESS, while promoting systems thinking & better planning





Applicable to the Country Support Modality and the DAE Support Modality*

Strategic, medium-term programmes based on 4-year planning

ONE multi-year PROGRAMME

→ 4 years

 mid-term review to course correct in evolving circumstances & priorities ('still fit-for-purpose?')

or

TWO multi-year PRORGAMMES

- → Based on planning for 4 years
- With any combination of USD values allocated between the two programmes. Used when requirements are not suited for the integrated approach

Programme size

- Country modality:
 - Min size USD 1 M
 - Max USD 7.32 M
- DAE modality:
 - Max size USD 1 M

Intentional about efficiency, speed, predictability

TRANSITIONAL MEASURES





To address existing and immediate needs, a *BAU* readiness proposal for up to **USD 1 Million** can be prepared for submission by 31 December 2024. All 'transitional'/legacy proposals must be approved by 31 March 2025 → deducted from of 2024 -2027 budget.



To continue supporting National Adaptation Plan formulation (NAP.1), USD 3 Million can be utilized for submission as a stand-alone proposal or as a request for proposal based on the four-year planning.

GCF PLACEMENT SCHEME



Purpose

Build the institutional capacity necessary for effective and consistent engagement with the GCF

GCF directly processes the consultant fees (National UN rates)

Associated costs must be budgeted under the country modality

Budget source

LDC/SIDS - Dedicated readiness window

Other countries – Readiness country window

Contract duration

180 working days through 11 months and 29 days

Place of work

NDA offices or any other agency if designated by the NDA

GCF PLACEMENT SCHEME



PHASE 1. REQUEST

- NDA request
- TOR customization
- Agree MoU between NDA and GCF

PHASE 2. RECRUITMENT

- Default local hire
- Contract between GCF and consultant
- NDA and GCF coselection process

PHASE 3. ONBOARDING

- Access to NDA and GCF systems
- Remote onboarding on GCF support and processes

PHASE 4. MANAGEMENT

- Subregional Lead interface between placement and GCF
- Day-to-day reporting to the NDA
- Monthly timesheet (cleared by NDA)
- Quarterly report
- Annual performance evaluation
